### KEY FACTS DELFT SYMPHONY

- Western Cape Department of Human Settlements is the developer
- Ibuyile is the turnkey contractor
- The Housing Development Agency (HDA) is the project manager
- The project will deliver 1 849 houses

### PROGRESS TO DATE DELFT SYMPHONY

- **House Construction**  
The contractor recommenced with construction during November 2010. The first handovers were done in December 2010. Construction of the remaining houses is currently underway and progressing well.
- **Beneficiaries**  
Beneficiaries will come from informal settlements in Nyanga, Malawi Camp and Freedom Farm, as well as backyarders.

- **Electricity Supply**

Eskom has inadequate capacity to supply electricity and it is working on increasing this capacity by building a new substation.

### FORTHCOMING IMPORTANT EVENTS DELFT SYMPHONY

Electricity Supply - Eskom has indicated that construction will commence in August 2011.
