NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP TO ASSESS LESSONS LEARNT FROM A CASE STUDY AND INITIATIVES GOING FORWARD

BACKGROUND

The eKhaya Neighbourhood Development initiative was started in Hillbrow in 2004. It has engaged a number of key local stakeholders including landlords in a number of initiatives in this challenging part of Johannesburg's Inner City. In 2011 the HDA commissioned a review of the eKhaya initiative with the specific intention to better understand what parts of the experience could contribute to similar initiatives in other urban areas in South Africa.

The first draft of the assessment and proposals for using the lessons elsewhere is ready. The HDA is now convening a workshop for stakeholders in eKhaya and other urban regeneration initiatives to comment on and add to the report and its proposals.

PURPOSE OF WORKSHOP

- For stakeholders to comment and contribute to the report and its recommendations.
- To assess and define the best ways of using lessons from this initiative in other places.

OUTPUTS OF WORKSHOP

- Improvement to the report based on stakeholder comments and critiques.
- Draft a proposal on how to use the lessons learnt for key stakeholders.

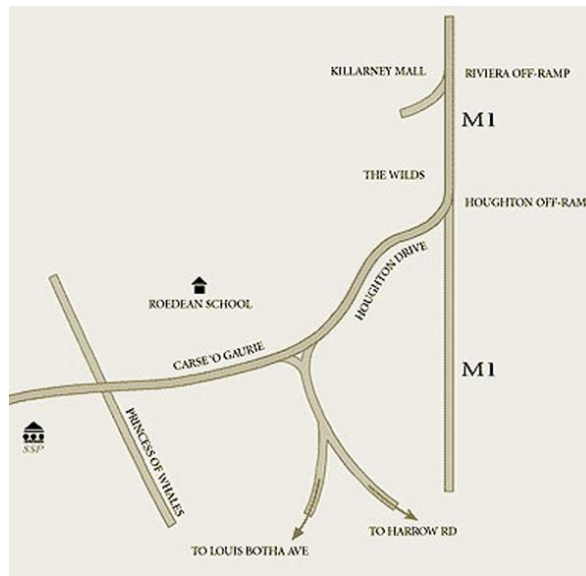
